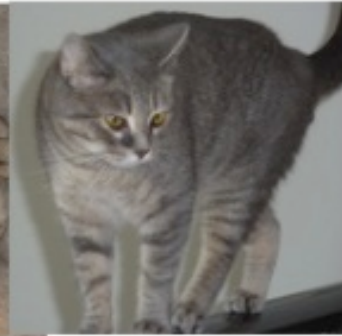
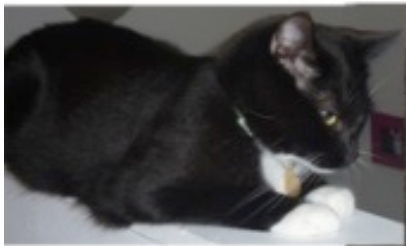

The parents were renting their daughter's apartment for her. The lease will expire in mid July. They will not renew it. Their daughter is not coming back. She is recovering physically, but has some serious psychological problems. So right now, the cats are perfect. They're healthy, friendly, playful, and trusting. They try to sniff your nose, eyes, and ears as if they just can't get close enough. They are so excited to have a person there to interact with. They love people and each other. They don't know that the sand is quickly running out of their hourglass. The parents will come from NY in mid July to close the apartment for good. They are not cat people and are both very allergic. The 4 remaining boys range in age from 1 ½ to 2 ½. Socks, Rascal, Mittens, and Tweak are neutered, UTD on all shots...and so sweet!
